Mårten Winge new CEO at Doxa

“Doxa has entered a new phase during 2011 and the Board therefore believes that the company needs a CEO with a different profile. The focus is now on marketing, international sales and future product development. Mårten Winge, with a strong background in the life science industry, will now take over the baton,” says Board Chairman Lars Eric Utterman.

Mårten has almost 25 years of experience from senior positions in the life science industry. He is currently responsible for business development at Denator AB. He was previously CEO of the Danish proteomics company Proxeon which was successfully sold to Thermo Fischer Scientific in April 2010.

Before Proxeon, Mårten was a cofounder and Executive Vice President of O-Link. He has also served on the board of O-Link. Previous positions have been Vice President Marketing at Celectricon and Vice President Marketing, Sales and Support at Pyrosequencing (now part of Biotage AB).

The Board of Doxa, in agreement with Fredrik Alpsten, has decided that Fredrik will leave his position as President and CEO of Doxa by the end of October 2011, but stay on until year end to support Mårten in his new role.

“Fredrik Alpsten has worked for Doxa for over 10 years of which almost three years as CEO. He has contributed greatly to the company’s progress to date and I would like to thank Fredrik for his valuable contribution to the company” says Utterman in a concluding comment.
